- You might as well not bother.

Here's what you should ask

What kind of carpet have I got here?

Can I see material data sheets for the chemicals you are using?

Are you professionally trained or was it trial and error?

If he/she answers trained ask to see their qualification certificates.

Ask to see their liability insurance certificate.

If your cleaner cannot answer these questions then you should think seriously before

Allowing them to clean your carpets and upholstery.

How does the operator know the fabric type? If the operator samples and tests the carpet then this is a good start. If he runs his hand over it before giving his answer he is just guessing.



A look at what's on offer

John uses the most modern high tech professional machines. Modern cleaning heads are used to provide the highest service,

The fabric is lifted from the foam filling of your upholstery, this makes drying much quicker and cleaning much more intense.

The machine is capable of operating at up to 600psi. John also offers total solvent or "dry cleaning" to give it its more common term.

He has Rota Vac cleaning which instead of dragging a cleaning head across your carpet manually it rotates the same motion but up to 1800 times a minute. This is much more efficient and leaves surfaces drier. The chemical compound used by John is a water soluble dry compound which when dissolved does not form a liquid which would allow rapid re-soiling. Any residue left carries on working and is thereafter removed by your domestic vacuum.

Fabrics are wonderful enhancements to our homes.

Failure to carry out initial tests prior to

cleaning can spell disaster for your fabrics and floor coverings. If your carpet or suite has worn prematurely call in the fiber detective who will help you understand why.

Fiber analysis is of fundamental importance in order to carry out proper maintenance.



Johns Tips for anyone who has just had their carpets or soft furnishings cleaned using water extraction

To speed up the drying process air movement is more important than heat. It is therefore better to get the air moving through the home with windows open where possible not so easy in winter.

In winter months it is better to use the heating system & where possible to utilize a summer office fan to move the air around.

Foil protectors or foam blocks must always be used beneath furniture until

you are sure that the fabrics are completely dry otherwise staining will occur from the transference of wood dyes, rust & other contaminants which will cause permanent irreversible damage.

Never walk on the clean carpet or floor with outdoor shoes. Just as importantly never walk on the damp surface with socks as dyes can bleed onto the carpet causing permanent staining.

Keep cushions off walls & radiators to prevent pressure marks.

Some upholstery contains tailor marks on the foam these are made using marker pens which when wet unless protected can bleed onto the fabrics.

Fiber drying times vary greatly, Carpet Fresh uses state of the art extraction and driers which leave upholstery & carpets much drier.

Remember stain protectors don't last forever they wear off. Ask about stain protection, a worth while small investment. Applied after cleaning.
